Gianna House Pregnancy & Parenting Residence is absolutely thriving. This is only possible because of you. You are helping us provide what we sometimes take for granted: a safe home, an opportunity to complete education and become employable, life and parenting skills and access to medical care that will lead to successful transition to selfsufficiency. Here are just a few of *your* accomplishments to make real, life-changing differences in the lives of young women and children who are falling through the cracks in our community:

- At-risk youth are being taken out of violent homes and off the streets and offered shelter. Our rooms are full. New rooms are in final preparations for additional residents.
- Some of our moms are transitioning back into families along with counseling and 30- & 90-day follow ups by our case manager. Some moms are finding employment and stable, independent housing and transitioning into our Outreach Programs.
- Mothers-to-be are receiving pre-natal care and bringing to birth full-term, healthy babies.
- Hundreds of our Outreach Program participants are not having to choose between diapers and other baby needs and how to feed their families or pay the rent.
- Our baby bucks program has been expanded. Now, in addition to earning essential baby needs through Bright-Course education modules, our outreach moms can volunteer at Gianna House and other community programs and can participate in community-based workshops to earn, at no cost, the items they need for baby. Now they add value to community.
- Gianna House is partnering with other community service organizations to help ensure all callers' needs are met, with all of us referring to each other as appropriate for assistance.

Together, we are transforming shared beliefs and hopes into action: housing, feeding, healing, educating, inspiring, enlightening, and nurturing the most vulnerable among us. Thank you for partnering with us.

First Gianna House Baby Turns 2!



She is continuing her education and just accepted a new employment opportunity. We are so very proud to have been a part of this young mother's success and her little man's healthy start in life!





Welcome to Gianna House!

Please welcome Brianna and baby boy Nasiah, our most recent residents of Gianna House! Bri, as she is affectionately known, is 20 years old and was seeking stable housing for her and then 2-month-old Nasiah when she first learned about Gianna House. After touring our facility, Brianna and Nasiah both received intakes into our residential program. Brianna states that she wishes to complete her high school credits and learn parenting skills that will assist her with becoming a better mom. Bri will also increase her daily living skills through employment and training so that she can transition to independent living.



Since her admittance to Gianna House, Bri has grown and matured a great deal. She recently facilitated a group presentation and demonstration on the ABCs of Safe Sleep and Swaddling. Her peers (other residents) and staff were in attendance. This is important to note because Bri also had to learn why it is not safe to co-sleep with Nasiah. She attended a 3-week Financial Literacy series hosted virtually by Comerica Bank and received a certificate of completion. Bri has learned about how to self-advocate with the appropriate affect and feels empowered by her successes so far. Baby Nasiah has made great strides too! He is now 3 months old and growing.
