
President's Message

With Fall upon us, leaves may be falling but no longer are the walls, floors, or ceilings at Gianna House. Because of your generous support, over \$200,000 was raised to rebuild our damaged residence. Additionally, through the generosity of Nancy Pulte Rikard and her consultants, we have a proposed new HVAC system to secure our infrastructure and ensure proper heating and cooling for our beloved Gianna House. This system ensures such a catastrophe doesn't occur again. With your winter emergency donations, we have secured:

- A plan for a new HVAC system (with special thanks as well to the Michigan Council of the Knights of Columbus for their 2022 contribution of \$10,000)
- Repaired kitchen, dining room and living areas
- Replastered and painted walls, ceilings, and stairwells in the south wing of the House
- New office spaces with refreshed floors, ceilings, & walls (special thanks to DTE Energy)
- Replaced carpeting and flooring where it was destroyed or damaged
- Restored lower level that can again store much needed diapers, wipes, formula, and baby supplies
- Replenished supplies, clothing, baby equipment and even computers for our community families. A viable residence again for four young women (two pregnant and two with infants) and 2 more babies on the way in early 2024!

With our restored lower level in place, over 30 community moms have returned to online learning and can now "shop" once again in our lower level for much needed supplies, clothing and baby necessities, sundries and equipment. Through the generous donation of Grosse Pointe benefactors, Jean and Thomas Lacey, and DTE Energy, there are freshly refurbished resident living spaces and staff offices. Extra DTE office cubicles gently used furniture and other accessories will be shared with needy community families after Gianna House is fully restored.

Under the expert direction of our Executive Director, Joella Bush, her dedicated staff, the board, and you, we have succeeded this year! Through your generosity and participation, the golf event generated over \$30,000 and our Mothers' Day event exceeded over \$6000. These two major Gianna House fundraisers were expertly executed with the support of Greystone Golf Club and the generosity of Maria and Charles Lamia of Lamia+Lamia Salon & Day Spa. Their support and direction supported another year of successful fundraising. We continue to express our thankfulness to all of you for your ongoing donations as well.



As 2023 closes, so does my presidency. I will continue as an advisor to the board. Over the past two years, our board members, staff, and advisors have:

- Revised our by-laws—to ensure we are accountable to your donor dollars in a meaningful way
- Amended our Articles of Incorporation—to direct the board and staff with mission and vision in mind
- Created a Three-Year Strategic Plan for 2023, 2024 and 2025—which guides our growth and sustainability
- Enhanced our metrics and reporting—to remain accountable to you our valued partners and grantors. Upgraded our database—to accurately manage vital metrics, reports and donor information
- Refined our mission, vision, and values—which refresh our perspective and drive
- Improved our website—to keep you timely informed of our efforts, successes, and challenges
- Expanded our board members, advisors, and donors—to sustain Gianna House's future leadership
- Restored Gianna House facilities—to continue Sr. Diane's mission of service to at-risk young women and infants in need.

Our focus and hope in 2024 is to double our residential services. Your continued financial support will help secure this vision. Our attention also remains committed to expanding community-based learning and access to resources for the needy, low-income families in our area. The vision is to lead this community in premier care and service to those of us who have the least. Won't you please continue your support and dedication to Gianna House as I will? If we all keep an eye on the welfare of needy young lives, Gianna House remains viable. I hope you maintain your faith in us by continuing to support the mission and vision of our founder, Sister Diane Masson. Through the grace of God, we move forward in lending services and oversight that offer a hand up—not a handout—to those who need it most. As we do so, thank you for your continued faith in our good work.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH


Gianna House is proud to welcome our new Community Outreach Coordinator, Jennifer Shatz!
