
Celebrating 10 Years!

This month, Gianna House Pregnancy & Parenting Residence celebrates **10 years** since Sr. Diane Masson filed the Articles of Incorporation for a new nonprofit that would provide a safe haven for at-risk pregnant youth — a need that was not being filled by any other community service or government agency.

Every organization has its phases and we are no exception. The first could be called the *Creative Phase* during which the Board focused on location, construction, and meeting building codes (bricks & mortar). The second phase was *Administrative* in nature and produced a muchneeded Outreach Program as well as the State Licensure, policies and procedures, programs and educational initiatives, and staffing required to open as a Residence Program. We accepted our first residents almost two years ago and during those two years have tracked results, tweaked processes based on preliminary experiences, and have expanded our outreach.

We are now entering a *Transformational* stage to take Gianna House to the next level in order to optimally serve the maximum number of moms and babies. With two years of Residence experience under our belts, programs and processes are being reviewed and refined; the staffing model is being revamped; networking is being expanded and alliances sought; and new revenue streams are under consideration.

By the grace of God and the guidance of his precious Holy Spirit, the leadership of Gianna House is being good stewards with your gifts and will continue to keep you up to date on the lives we are saving because of your faithfulness. Please continue to keep us in your prayers.

The caring and sharing of 56 people brought rich blessings to 43 of our Community Outreach mothers and their children at Christmastime. Responding to an invite posted on Facebook, they chose to gift one or more children with a toy and article of clothing. Adrian Dominican Sister Pat Magee facilitated this project for 118 children, contacting mothers to obtain each child's age, sex, size, and a toy suggestion. Sharing this with sponsors, wrapped and labeled gifts began pouring into Gianna House to be picked up the week before Christmas. One mother emailed: "Thank you for helping my little boy and girl, I was so happy I cried."

One sponsor spread blessings beyond Gianna House by purchasing 43 festive boxes of special Christmas cookies to help not only our families, but also her local caterer at this time of economic challenge to businesses. And not to leave out our mothers, each received a special gift bag with a scarf fashioned by our crocheting teacher and her friends, a packet of toiletries prepared by a GH friend and her family, a pair of slippers purchased by "Slippers for Mom," and a \$50 gift card provided by a new donor and her friends. Indeed, blessings, upon blessings, upon blessings!

Throughout the pandemic, Gianna House has continued to offer mothers needing baby items and online classes four days a week on parenting, birthing, personal growth, nutrition, life skills, and even Zumba. The only onsite class offered was sewing, limited to four students at socially distanced machines.

One mother, Alissa, who has participated in almost all of our classes over the past two years including sewing, emailed: "Gianna House gave me a little extra gift that I want to share with you. I'm excited that Gianna House taught me something I love to do, and a job came out of it based on me talking about the knowledge I knew from class!" She was hired by a local store to help sew their merchandise. We applaud Alissa and rejoice with her.
